

Change log for ASCII Video Terminal firmware Ver 1.3

- Added escape codes to turn the cursor off and on.
ESC [?25l Will turn the cursor off (ie, make invisible)
ESC [?25h Will turn the cursor on (ie, show the cursor)
- Note that the documentation for previous versions listed the video resolution for composite video incorrectly. The correct specifications are (changes are underlined):
 - Composite PAL displays 18 lines by 48 characters or 288 pixels (x axis) by 216 (y axis)
 - Composite NTSC displays 15 lines by 44 characters or 264 pixels (x axis) by 180 (y axis)

Change log for ASCII Video Terminal firmware Ver 1.2

- Corrected a bug which corrupted USB data when in composite PAL mode.
- Corrected a bug which restricted composite (both PAL and NTSC) to a line width of 34 characters.

Note: V1.1 was the first release although the file was labelled V1.0
